# The Importance of Setting Personal and Professional Boundaries

Boundaries are like lines on a playing field, they help us know where we need to stay within our professional roles. Many students struggle with boundaries, making it essential for staff to set and maintain personal and professional boundaries. The below four boundaries are great guidelines to maintain healthy boundaries with students:

- **1. Staff/student boundary.** Establish yourself as a staff person rather than a friend.
- 2. Work/home boundary. What happens at home should stay at home. Maintain a separation between your home and work life.
- **3. Personal distance boundary.** Keep appropriate distance between you and the students. This may include not giving hugs or standing too close.
- **4. Advice giving boundary.** Make sure to keep your advice contained to within your professional role, such as educational matters or social issues that come up at school.

Setting these boundaries help to preserve your ability to work with students while maintaining a focus on learning. Boundaries also protect you from accusations of impropriety or favoritism, model healthy student-teacher relationships for students, and preserve your privacy by keeping the focus on school.
